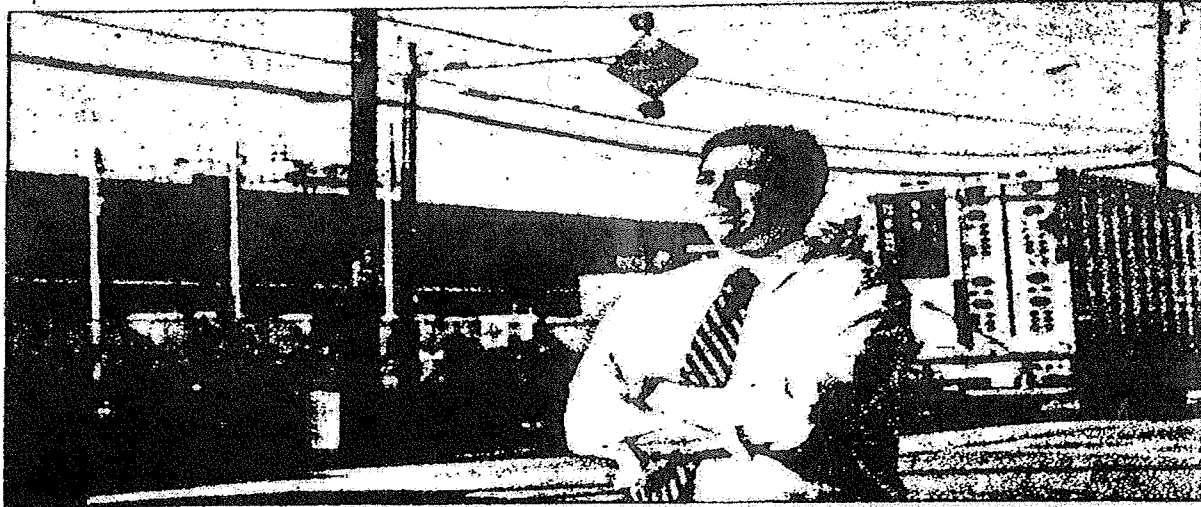


**Why is this man trying to drive
