

This permit shall not be deemed and is not a property or vested right, and may be revoked or suspended pursuant to law. All requirements listed must be followed in order for the permit to remain valid.

## Event Permit Requirements for Occupy Louisville

1. Applicant may use Founder's Square 24/7 through March 31, 2012 and may erect tents.
2. Enclosed tents over 200 sq. ft. require a separate permit and any tents over 400 sq. ft., enclosed or otherwise, also require a separate permit. No tent of any size be placed, in whole or in part, on the public sidewalks within or adjacent to Founder's Square.
3. Unless applicant pays for electric, none will be provided. If applicant wants electric, a \$500 deposit in form of cash or cash equivalent (no personal checks or credit cards) must be tendered to the Department of Codes and Regulations no later than 4 p.m., February 3, 2012. If LG&E electric bill based on Founder's Square electric meter during permit period is less than deposit, remainder will be refunded to individual that tenders deposit. If LG&E electric bill based on Founder's Square meter during permit period exceeds deposit, excess will be charged to individual who signed application. In the event applicant opts for electric usage, all electrical connections and use must conform to code and no extension cords will be permitted across public sidewalks within or adjacent to Founder's Square.
4. Based on applicant's addendum to the application indicating that up to 70 protestors will be on site 24/7, applicant must provide 3 portable restroom facilities and have them in place within 3 business days of the date of this permit.
5. Founder's Square must remain clean of trash, debris, and rubbish at all times.
6. Applicant must have an OSHA compliant First Aid kit (or call EMS to get description or identify of recommended kit) on site 24/7. Applicant shall produce first aid kit for inspection by Department of Codes and Regulations representative within 3 business days of the date of this permit.
7. Permit expires March 31, 2012.
